**FAMOUS MUSICAL ARTISTS
TO VISIT HERE NOV. 27**

Renowned Canadian Tenor, Paul Dufault, and Emil Taranto, Violinist, and Alfred Carrier, Pianist Here on the 27th.

One of the most interesting and pleasing announcements that has ever come to the music-loving people of Timmins is brought to the attention of our readers by the fact that arrangements have been made through the influence of Rev. Father Theriault to bring here the renowned Canadian Tenor, Paul Dufault, accompanied by two other gifted artists, Emil Taranto, violinist, and Alfred Carrier, pianist.

Every Canadian should be proud to hear and applaud the brilliant Canadian Tenor who has made the Canadian name greater to the foreign nations. Paul Dufault has already a lasting reputation in all parts of the world; even into the regions of far-away China, down into the jungle districts of Africa, and in the greatest cities of Europe has the voice of this Canadian endeared him to the hearts of all races.

The celebrated Irish Tenor, John McCormack, has said of Paul Dufault that his voice is "Magnificent, powerful, beautiful!"

To-day (to measure his fame and popularity by one well-known test) his gramophone records tie in popularity (and price) with those of Caruso.

This artist, perhaps the greatest tenor that we can hear to-day, lives with his songs; he passes through all the musical emotions they contain; his rich voice expresses what he feels. Like Jean de Reske, Dufault's voice is capable of an infinite variety of shading and at all times it is rich and warm in color. "The Age" of Melbourne, Australia, says of him:—"Paul Dufault is a tenor who need fear comparison with none. The even quality of his voice and the exquisite purity of his enunciation are worthy of all possible praise. In short, Paul Dufault is a singer to hear and hear again."

Emil Taranto is known as the best pupil of the great master, Baye, and Alfred Carrier has long since reached the pinnacle of fame in metropolitan centres.

**MONTREAL CAPITAL FOR
PAINKILLER LAKE MINE.**

Mr. M. Attallah recently made a trip to Montreal and while there it is understood he interested Montreal capitalists in the property at Painkiller Lake in which he is interested, and as a result a company is being organized to develop the holdings and make a mine of them. Mr. Attallah's property is alongside the Hattie Mines which have been showing much promise, so that the prospects for the Painkiller Lake section are now beginning to look up. There are several very likely properties in this district and if one or more of them were taken up, amply financed and thoroughly explored, it is likely that the results would be such as to make a general boom in the Painkiller section. This, at least, is the opinion of many shrewd prospectors who know the district and have great hopes for its future. On the Attallah holdings gold and tellurides have been reported as being uncovered in work done during the past few months and the general outlook from present indications would certainly seem to be encouraging, to say the least. Few well acquainted with the Painkiller Lake district doubt but that if one good property gets well under way it will only be the signal for a number of others to get going as soon as labor and other conditions will permit.
