

LUXURY TAX

In accordance with budget introduced on May 19th, 1920, we are now obliged to collect a tax on the purchase price of certain articles selling for over a specified amount

Hollinger employees are reminded that through their coupons they are enabled to purchase many articles at prices which are under the amounts fixed as taxable.

For instance, a \$10 pair of boots are subject to a tax of 10 per cent., making the price \$11, however, a Hollinger employee gets 15 per cent. discount from the original \$10 bringing the price down to \$8.50, which is under the amount fixed as taxable.

This increases the value of Coupons, the actual saving as shown above on a \$10 purchase being \$2.50

Luxury Tax where levied is payable only in CASH
