The man arrested for illegally transporting liquor was dismissed. The transfer men who identified him as the gentleman giving the check to release the trunk in question, gave a different date on the witness stand to the day on which effort was made to release this particular trunk. The result was that the case could not be upheld against the man in question. The trunk and joyful contents were confiscated.
