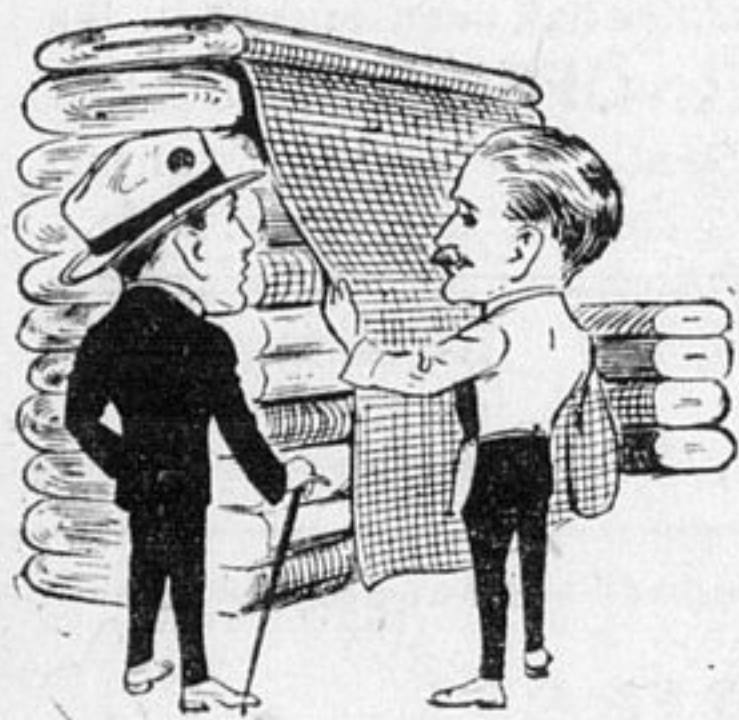

PITCHER PLANTS USED AS DRINKING VESSELS

In reference to the mention made recently in The Advance to the species of pitcher plant found in this locality, Mr. Wm. Baacke, a well-known old-timer of the North Land who has spent much of his time in the past few years in the bush section of the country, has some interesting details to give. Mr. Baacke says that this species of pitcher plant (Sarracenia) is very plentiful in the swamp a half mile north of Tate Lake within one mile of Des Quinze. And speaking of Des Quinze, and with further reference to a recent article in The Advance giving the derivation of North Land place names, Mr. Baacke points out that Des Quinze is simply French for "Fifteen," and the name was given from the fact that there are fifteen rapids on the river. This suggests that for many years the rapids on this river have held a special significance, but to-day this significance is largely increased because of the harnessing of the rapids and the development of power therefrom. Because of the water power development Des Quinze has become more or less famous, and certainly is now well known, at least by name, to many who otherwise would not have heard of the river or the section of country. Even with all the publicity growing from the power development, however, there is some confusion. Many know the name, but can not pronounce it. Others pronounce it about right but would not know the name if they met it in their newspaper.

But to return to the Sarracenia! Mr. Baacke says these pitcher plants present an attractive appearance when in full growth. But men who travel the bush and the unexplored areas are not always content with mere beauty. They find uses for the Sarracenia. In the boggy places where the plants grow they are useful in making a more or less safe stepping place, the leaves usually being full of water, and thus forming a sort of cushion on which the marshy spots may be stepped over by a nimble pair of feet. Often, too, the leaves are carefully torn away from the roots, the tops trimmed off and the vase-like leaf then used as a drinking vessel. These vase-like leaves hold water and are superior to the "palm" method for drinking purposes in the bush. The pitcher plant does not hold a great deal of water, but still it makes a fair sort of drink-

ing cup when a better is not available.

For the benefit of The Toronto Star, however, it might be well to add that the pitcher plant is not the exclusive drinking cup used in the North Land. When the wolves allow people to come out and around in this country, the folks are just as liable as not to use china or glass drinking vessels. On one occasion The Star secured the services of a University Professor to find out whether a 15-year-old lad from Cincinnati was telling the truth about the North Land. Would it be asking too much of The Star to suggest that the services of some equally prominent scientist be secured to discover whether the pitcher plants may be used for home-brew,—with safety to the plant and to the home-brew.

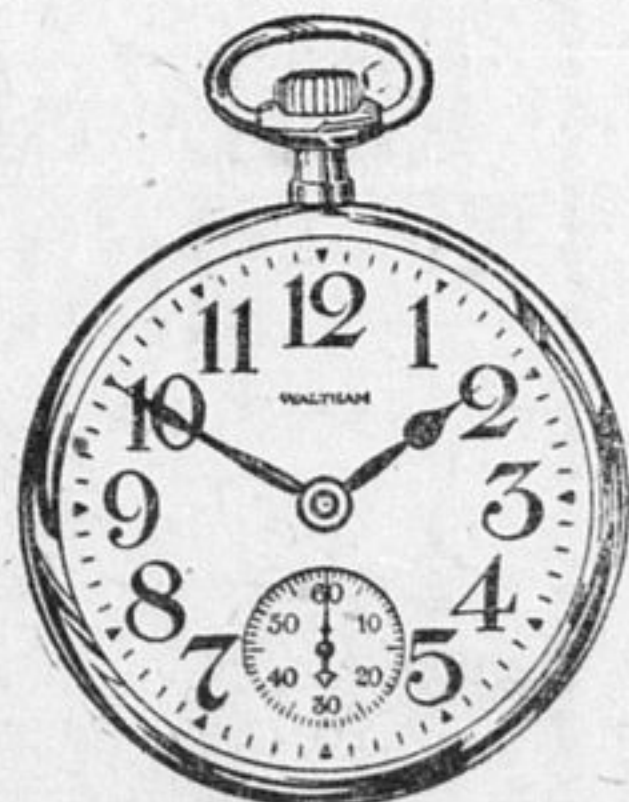

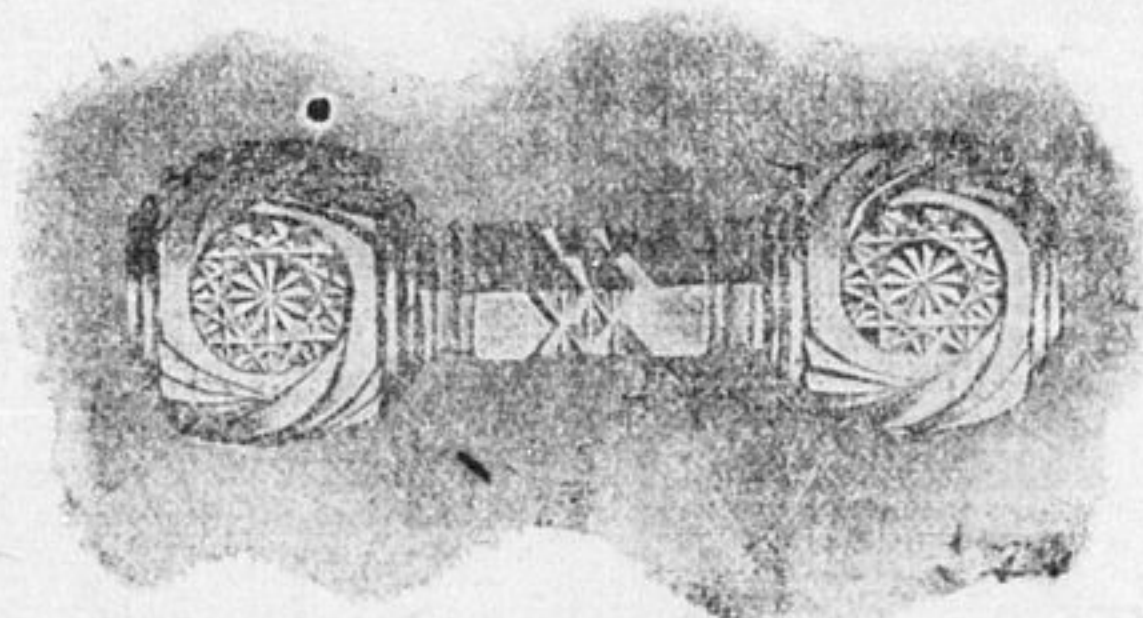
