MIGHT INCREASE VALUE OF GOVERNMENT REPORTS

During the past few days The Advance has received official reports re garding experimental stations and other government activities. The re ports are for the year 1923, and they are being issued now-in October, 1924. Naturally such reports, issued so long after the period covered, lose much of their value through the unnecssary delay in publication.
