## HON. BENIAH BOWMAN WAS ONE OF THE MENNONITES.

The Englehart Board of Trade recently considered the question of the suitability of Mennonites as settlers for this North Land. One member of nonites were particularly fine people and as there were numbers of them looking for locations now it might be well to get in touch with them with a view to having them as colonists in the North Land. The Board decided to follow the suggestion, but before action was taken a letter published in the Englehart paper rather turned opinion about. This letter from a Boston Creek man told about Mennonite settlements in the West that had proved unsatisfactory from the standpoint of the country. The Board of Trade at Englehart decided to shelve the question, at least for the present. In connection with the matter it may be noted that Hon. Beniah Bowman, Minister of Lands & Forests, in the Drury Cabinet, was of the Mennonite persuasion. In the North Land there is a more or less general opinion that the Hon. Beniah would have been a pretty good man for the North Land, had it not been for the U.F.O. Premier, Hon. E. C. Drury. Hon. Beniah had a heart and could be pressed to promise things. Then along would come the Premier and upset all the promises like automatic apple-carts. Leaving the Englehart Board of Trade to finish its problem of deciding as to whether or not the Mennonites would make good settlers for the North Land, it may be said that if one particular one were to come here he should not bring Hon. E. C. Drury along with him, as there are enough temptations now in the North Land for assault, battery and wholesome murder.
