The Hollinger Recreation Club had a successful and useful career during the past year. A report recently prepared by the Secretary, Mr. J. Blackshaw, indicates the scope of the activities of the club and the success and benefit with which the affairs have been carried through.

The Hollinger Recreation Club has the use of the Hollinger Recreation Hall in the Hollinger Townsite on certain days and nights of the week. The excellent dancing floor is marked out for basketball and may be used for badminton.

There is a tennis court adjacent to the Hall, which is available to members during the summer.

The Hollinger Recreation Club owns athletic goods and equipment as follows:-

Basketball equipment.
Badminton set.
Set of quoits.
Tennis nets, posts and markers.
Baseball outfit.
Indoor baseball equipment.

Membership in the Hollinger Recreation Club runs from January 1st. to December 31st. yearly. A small fee is charged to defray running expenses and for the purpose of accumulating a reserve to be used in the furthering of recreative and

athletic activities and for the replacement of worn out equipment.

During 1924, under the able guidance of Mr. Len Cousins, president of the club, assisted by his officers a highly successful year was brought to a conclusion with a small cash balance on hand. A considerable quantity of sportin equipment had been secured and much ground work done in arousing an interest in athletic and recreative activities.

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING COCHRANE DISTRICT C.A.S.

The regular Monthly Meeting of the Cochrane District Children's Aid Society was held last Wednesday evening in the Society's office, Dr. Moore Block, Timmins. The President, Reeve C. V. Gallagher, was in the chair, and those present included Rev. J. D. Parks, Mrs. E. L. Longmore, Dr. J. A. McInnis, Rev. C. Armstrong Sales (Schumacher); Capt. Cornthwaite, S.A., Local Superintendent O. Robertson, and Mr. R. LeHeup, Local Superintendent of Temiskaming Children's Aid Society.

There was discussion on the question of the Government giving special appropriations for the work in unorganized districts of the North.

The matter for a site for the proposed new Shelter for this district was also considered and discussed.

Inspector LeHeup gave interesting and helpful suggestions on the questions referred to above, and also on the handling of juvenile delinquents,

especially at the commencement of their delinquency.

Local Superintendent Robertson told the gathering that he had recently taken up the question of aid to unorganized territories in regard to C. A. S. work, when interviewing Mr. J. Kelso, Superintendent for Ontario of Neglected and Dependent Children, and Mr. Kelso was recommending to the Government that this aid be given.
