> SPEAKER'S CASTING VOTE SAVES KING GOVERNMENT

The casting vote of the Speaker, necessary for the first time in the history of a Dominion parliament, saved the MacKenzie King Government from technical defeat in the House of Commons last week. A motion regarding the rules of the House had been made by a private member. The Government declined to accept it and it was taken to a vote. The division 2 was a party one, all the Government members voting in the negative, all Conservatives and all agrarians, with two exceptions voted in favor. The result was a dead heat. Speaker Lemieux then gave his casting vote. He voted with the Government, in the negative, and the motion was thus deafeated.
