Lower School Examination At the Timmins High School

List of Pupils Passing in the Various Subjects. Certificates Will be Distributed at Re-Opening of School. Examination covers the Work of First Two Years at High School.

From Mr. J. W. Treleven, Principal of the Timmins High School, The Advance has secured the list of the pupils passing the Lower School Examination in the High School here. This list is published herewith. Mr. Treleven has also made the following explanatory notes:—

Credits granted, 311. Papers written 380. Per cent successful 82.

The Department of Education has issued certificates of Lower School standing to pupils of Timmins High School who were successful at the recent midsummer examinations. These certificates will be distributed at the re-opening of school on September 1st. The figure "1" indicates that the candidate has been successful in the subject stated at the head of the column. The Lower School certificate is essential for admission to Normal Schools for Second and First Class teachers' professional certificates. The examination covers the first two years' work of the High School course. The subjects of examination in the first year are Canadian History, Geography, Art and Botany; in the second year, Physiography, Arithmetic, Zoology and English Grammar or Latin Grammar.

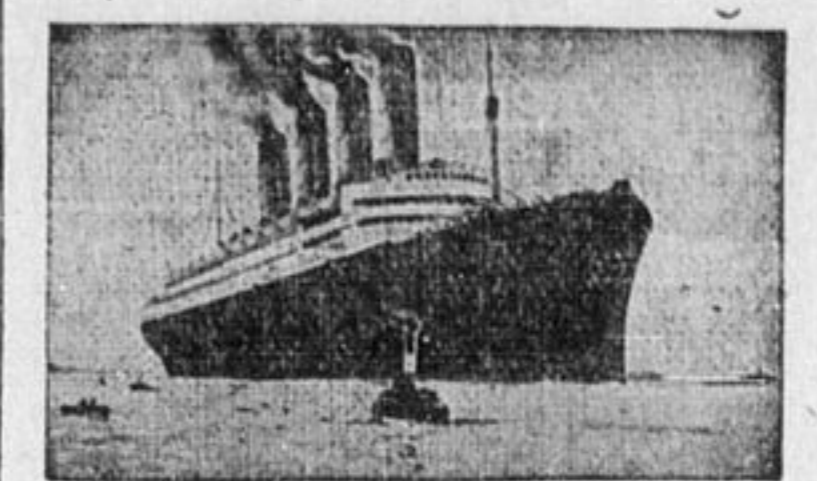
