**LIQUOR STORE TO OPEN
HERE FIRST WEEK IN JULY**

Will be Located in Building on Balsam Street Behind N. Blahey's Store. Another Building for Beer Warehouse

Information to hand this week is to the effect that the Government Vendor's store for Timmins will be opened likely about the first or second week in July. An inspector was here some days ago and the building on Balsam street, back of N. Blahey's store was selected as the premises for the store. A separate beer warehouse will also be secured, but the exact location of this has not yet been definitely decided upon.

In passing it may be noted that contrary to despatches appearing in some outside newspapers there has been no general dissatisfaction or complaint relative to the delay in establishing the store here. The people have been fair enough to recognize that there were many details to be worked out in connection with the opening of the stores and that a slight delay was quite justified. Further, they were aware that Mr. A. F. Kenning was very carefully looking after the local interests, and that he would see that everything possible was done to facilitate matters. After standing the O. T. A. so long, the people were ready to give the Government a fair chance, and, further, they felt every confidence in all concerned and were certain that all expedition was being made.

There is no official announcement in the matter but it is understood that in the next few weeks stores will be opened at Timmins, Cochrane and Haileybury, and that at a comparatively early date stores will also be opened at Iroquois Falls and Kirkland Lake.

given to those at the new mining camp.

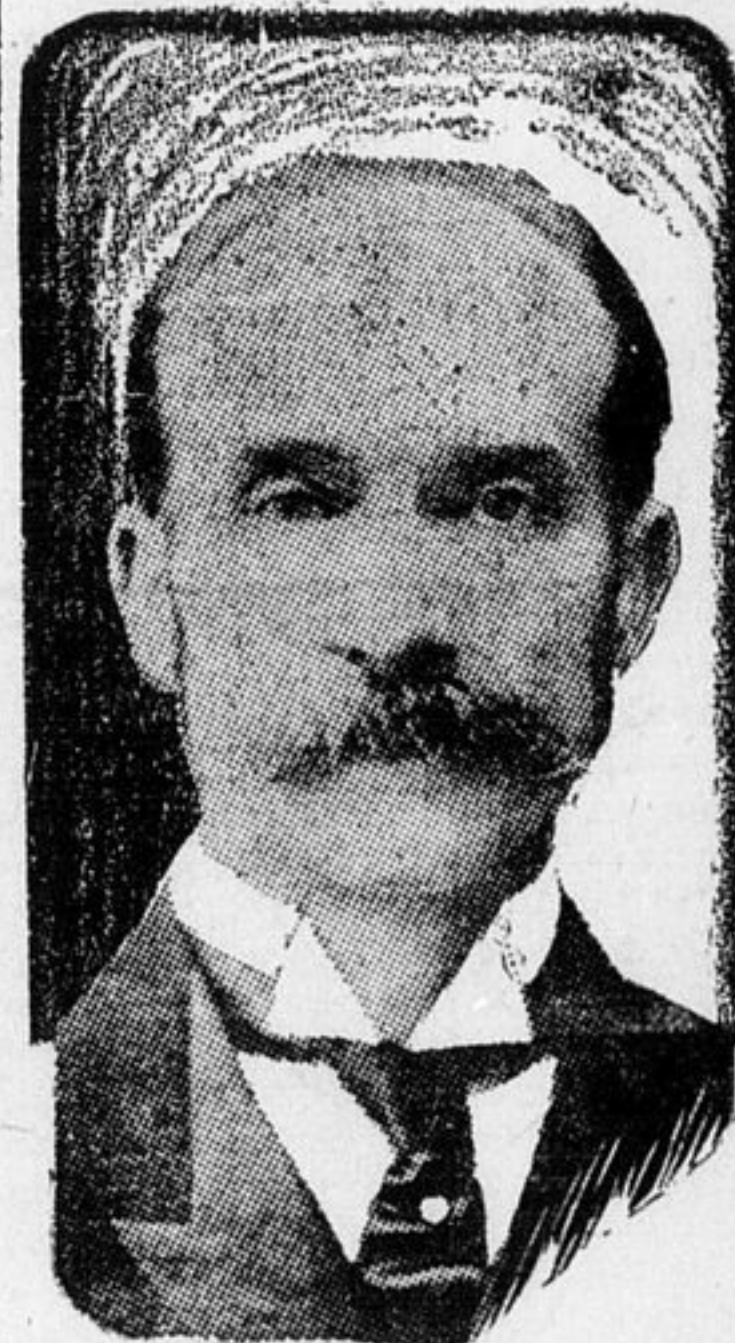
