#### NEED FOR FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT EMPHASIZED

The following editorial article appeared in the last issue of The Kirkland Lake Northern News:--

New Liskeard and Timmins are increasing their fire fighting equipment with modern appliances. These towns are not waiting for a conflagration to show the need of fire fighting equipment but are preparing for it.

Kirkland Lake have at the present time all the equipment required to handle any fire that may possibly occur. True we have no fire truck, but the town is well equipped, and the equipment so placed that it is ready when needed. In another year or so a fire truck will be needed and will then be purchased. Water pressure is good any place in the town and increased pumping capacity is ready if required.

The experience of the town of Newmarket is an example of false economy. They have there a small truck converted into a fire truck. No ladders of consequence, no gas masks, and a water pressure inadequate to cope with big fires. Last summer the new hospital was burned down and a week ago the high school fell prey to the flames. Now that the damage is done, they realize the need of better fire fighting equipment and will no doubt get it.

The Newmarket Express-Herald is to be complimented in their editorial dealing with this subject and ends up by saying "Is it any wiser to spend \$40,000 on pavements (last year) than \$6,000 on fire prevention? Let council bring on the vote and let Newmarket wake up to the fact that it is living in the year 1928."
