Extensive Use of Airplanes In Prospecting in the North

John E. Hammell, President, and J. H. Black, Vice-President of Northern Aerial Minerals Exploration, Limited, intend to place forty parties in the field. Five Fokker Planes Now on Order.

Faith and imagination, combined with technical skill and wide experience in the country and its prospecting, appear to be ideal qualities to bring to a project for the development of the mineral resources of the North Land. These are qualities that John E. Hammell has to a noteworthy degree, and to them may be added the fact that he enjoys the respect and confidence of all who know him.

The five Fokker planes will be designed for 1,000 mile flying range, this being made possible with specially constructed gasoline tanks. All planes will be equipped with pontoons, interchangeable in winter with skids for landing on ice. They are designed for 100 miles per hour. Capacity will be 1,500 pounds of cargo, or six passengers and crew.

"The company has been formed for the purpose of thoroughly exploring for and developing the rich natural resources of Canada; of organizing the business of exploration and developing natural resources; and of bringing the modern, high-powered and completely proven airplane into service for the purpose of prospecting for, acquiring, examining, exploring, testing, developing, operating and disposing of gold, silver, copper, nickel, lead, zinc, iron, coal and other precious, semi-precious and base metal properties, and for the purpose of exploring for, prospecting, developing, operating and disposing of other natural resources including oil, pulp and timber lands and hydro-electric power, in the explored and unexplored portions of the Dominion of Canada and elsewhere."

It is understood that one of the bases will be at Gold Pines and another at the Pas, Manitoba. The others will be located at more distant points it is believed. At present the location of the bases has not been named by the company. The intention evidently is to thoroughly prospect the whole North Country, especially the Patricia area and the newer sections of Manitoba.

Mr. John E. Hammell is the president and managing director of the new company ("N. A. M. E.") as it is becoming to be generally called. Mr. J. H. Black is vice-president, while Robt. Fennell, J. A. Richardson, E. H. Rose and other well-known names are on the directorate.

The prospectus states that by an agreement in writing, John E. Hammell has agreed to give the company the first opportunity to acquire all properties submitted to him (for the exploration and development of which the company was organized), upon the same terms and conditions as such properties are obtainable by him. For a dozen years or so The Advance has been emphasizing the possibilities of the airship in this North Land of great distances, so that the ambitious plans and proposals of the Northern Aerial Minerals Exploration, Limited, are noted with more than passing interest.

Five Fokker airplanes, of the largest type available, are at present on order, and two of these will be delivered in May, and the remaining three in June. From three to five smaller scout planes, the type of which has not yet been decided, will also be ordered. All planes will be equipped with oversized gasoline tanks, allowing for large cruising range.

Capt. H. A. Oaks, of Winnipeg will be the director of aerial operations, and under him will be a force of experienced men—airmen and prospectors. It is the company's intention to establish four bases from which the planes will operate, with at least two planes to a base. From each of these bases the management expect to have ten parties of prospectors operating over a wide radius. Each base will have a staff of pilots, mechanics, and one head prospector, who will also be a qualified sampler and competent to lay out surface development work.

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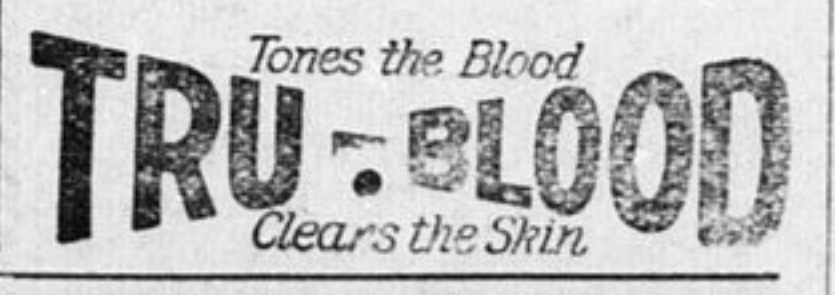

MANAGEMENT NOT AT ALL DISCOURAGED AT HOWEY

That the management was in no way discouraged with the results to date was the message given to the shareholders of Howey Gold Mines at the annual meeting at Toronto last week. Rather had they cause for satisfaction, said Manager Horace Young, since approximately one half of the vein structure opened up underground was in ore, a figure that compared very favourably with the record of the producing mines of the North.

Practically all of the dead work had been completed, said President J. E. Hammell, and work from now on would be entirely on development. It was planned to do from 8,000 to 10,000 feet of drilling in short holes along the drifts, to see what ore could be picked up. The richest ore in the mine had been struck at the 500-foot level, he stated, and slides had shown that tellurides were present, a very important factor.

There was no need to worry about the ore being cut off by granite, said

Mr. Hammell, quoting Dr. Bruce as his authority. Questioned by shareholders, he stated that no consideration of the construction of a mill had been given as yet, but that by the end of the summer more definite plans could be made. It was the intention to call in the share units about the first of July. The exchange was to be made on the basis of 400 shares for each unit. The directors were re-elected.

The Canadian Parliament recently voted \$1,900,000 for the maintenance and extension of the work carried on by the 24 Experimental Farms in Canada under the administration of the Canadian Federal Department of Agriculture. The money voted is for the next fiscal year. Twelve of the experimental farms are located in the five provinces east of Winnipeg and 12 in the four western provinces.
