ENCOURAGING REPORT ON HOWEY GOLD PROPERTY

Mr. J. E. Hammell, president of the Howey Gold Mines, has submitted a very encouraging report on the property for the period since June 16th. The report indicates that the width of ore on the 500-ft. level has been doubled.

"We are pleased to report that diamond drill hole No. 23, located 950 feet east of our present development faces, has cut 169 feet of wax-coloured porphyry, which is ore formation, and also ten feet of \$10.00 grade ore.

"Since the 16th of June, the date of our last report, instead of advancing on this level we have been busy side slashing the walls of the present drift in order to ascertain the size and grade of the orebody in this locality.

"The development work is going well on all levels of the mine and the results are good."
