The new legislation to provide for freer sale of beer and wine in Ontario was introduced last week in the Legisfrom the first. The Opposition caucus decided to acquiesce in the passing tions: of the legislation, taking the attitude that it should not be made a political

1—Sale of beer and wine with meals in dining-rooms in standard hotels and such other places, which would include restaurants and clubs, as the board and define. may decide.

2-Sale of beer by the glass in refreshment rooms in standard hotels and in veterans' and labour union clubs by the Liquor Control Board.
