Canada Northern Power Corporation Limited, plants at Wawaitin Falls (18 miles distant) and Sandy Falls (9 miles distant); also at the Quinze and Sturgeon Falls. Lots of cheap power available.	
RAILWAYS	
Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway. Canadian Pacific Railway operate Pullman service from and to Timmins once each day.	
TRANSPORTATION	
Dalton's Bus Line connects Timmins with Schumacher, Gold Centre, South Porcupine Dome Mines and Ankerite. Round trip 12 miles.	
MISCELLANEOUS DETAILS	
Mining, lumbering and farming main industries. Population: Canadians of British and French descent; Italians and Finlanders. English spoken by 98 p.c. of the people of Timmins and surrounding towns. Town and district boasts a Golf Course, 2 Skating Arenas and 2 Curling Rinks. Situated in centre of a rich and prosperous mining and lumbering area. Steady payrolls.
