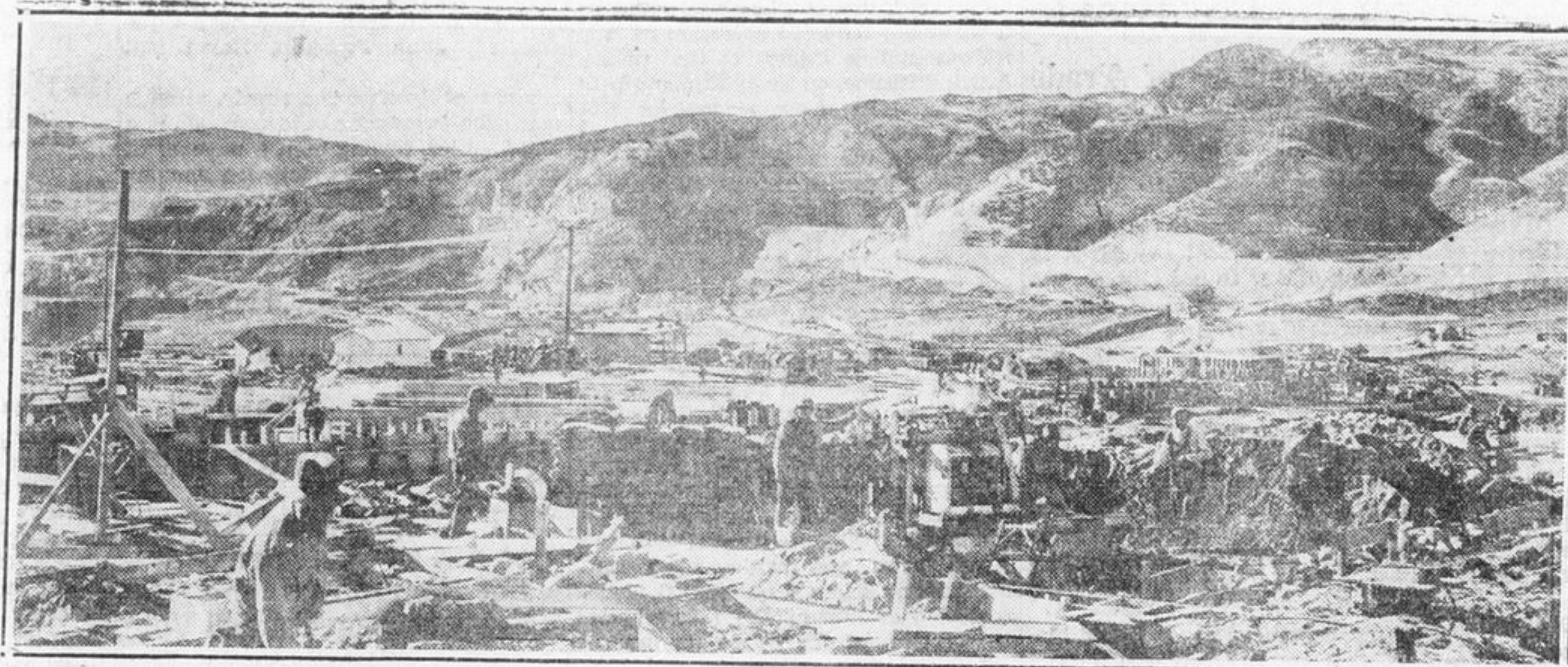
Little Shirley Temple had lots of opposition in these ducklings and only co-starred in this picture snapped by the photographer as he passed Shirley's backyard in Hollywood.

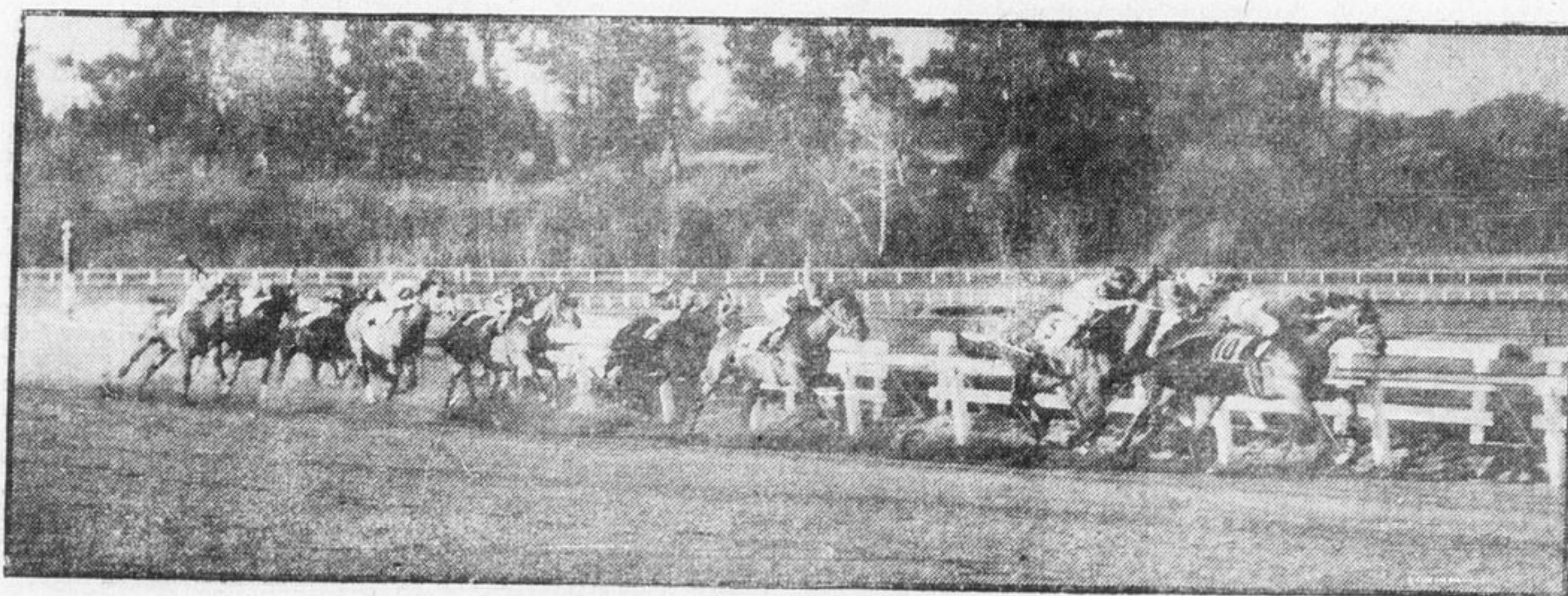
For First Appearance

CROWN PRINCE MICHAEL AND QUEEN HELEN

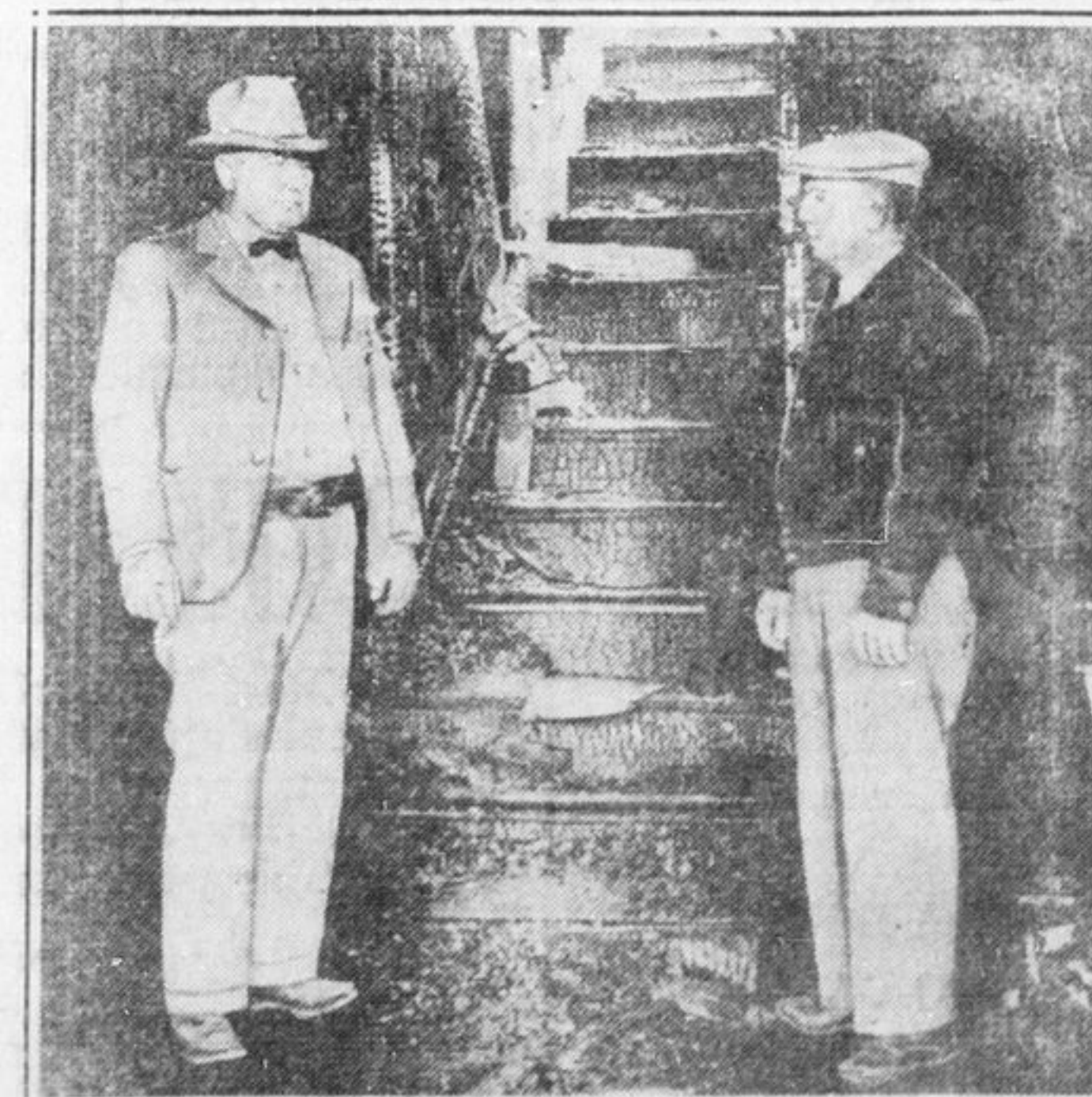
