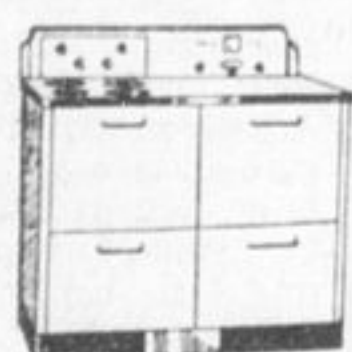

Big Improvement at Bourke's Rapids

Excellent Job Done in Short Time in Clearing Channel in River. Makes for Safety and Convenience.

Talk About Night Trains on T. & N. O.

Revival of Request for a Northbound and Southbound Evening Train. Not Likely to Materialize at Present.

Railwaymen up and down the T. & N. O. are discussing these days the possibility of a North Bay-Timmins overnight service both north and south bound.

No announcement has been made from official sources, but well-informed people here say that the service is not likely to be placed in effect.

According to a North Bay despatch, a north-bound train would leave the Bay at midnight, arriving in Timmins early in the morning.

"It is understood that the plans have so far advanced that a tentative running schedule has been worked out, calling for maintenance of high average speed for both night runs.

The proposed night train from here would arrive in North Bay early in the morning.

The train would be of no use for through traffic to Toronto, unless the C.N.R. put on another two daily trains, one arriving at North Bay late at night and the other leaving North Bay early in the morning.

It is understood that the movement for the night trains was begun by a group of commercial travellers but that when the general opinion of the travelling men was found, only a small number thought the service would be advantageous.

\$18,000 Production at the Gillies Lake

Increase in Output This Month Means Larger Profits. Additions Made to Equipment of Mine.

Production this month at Gillies

Lake Porcupine mine will be about \$18,000, it is estimated. This will mean profits of about \$10,000 in comparison with about \$7,300 during August.

The mill will be stepped up to 100 tons a day in the near future. The Advance was told last week. A new crusher, capable of handling 350 tons a day, is to be installed, together with a new 75-ton ball mill and a cyanide plant.

Men from the Denver equipment company were at the property last week and will have the new machines shipped as soon as possible.

The immediate improvements will fill the mill building to capacity, so that any additional equipment from now on will mean the erection of an addition.

The assay office is nearly complete and with the arrival last week of the scale, the last of the assaying equipment was placed.

Steam lines are now being laid to give the mine buildings central heating.

Engine Trouble Delayed C. N. R. Train on Friday

C.N.R. train 47 encountered engine trouble on Friday's run out of Toronto that held the express up for an hour and a half.

It arrived in Timmins about 6.15, so that the mail was not sorted until after seven o'clock.

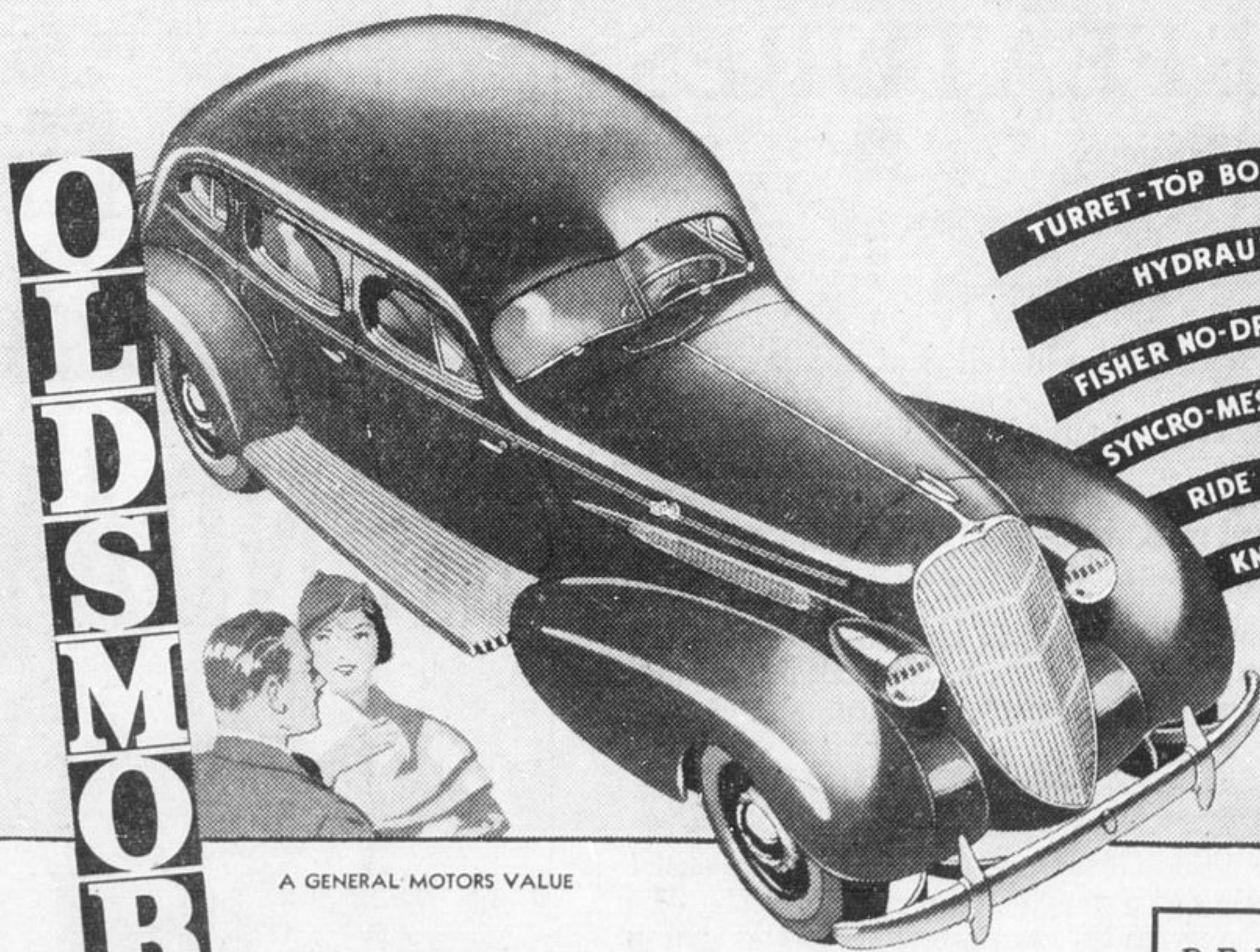
