

# First Complete List of Dominions Nominations

List of Candidates Arranged by Provinces and Constituencies for the Dominion Election Held Monday, October 14th. Previous Lists Published Separately After Dates of Nomination.

Here is the only complete list of nominations in to-day's election that has been published all in one place up to the present time. There are 243 constituencies, representing 245 seats in the House of Commons, two constituencies having two members. There were 895 nominees, all told. Nominations were held in 76 constituencies, including those in Northern Ontario, on September 30th, in order to allow for distribution of ballots in proper time. In the other 176 constituencies, nominations were held on October 1st.

In the following table members of the last house are indicated by an asterisk; figures in brackets after the name of the constituency indicate the majority obtained by the party there in 1930; in cases where there have been redistributed ridings, estimates based on that territory have been made.
