Authorization to open a new post office at the Shawkey gold mines has been received here by J. C. Ross, district superintendent of postal services.

The Shawkey gold mines are located two miles south of the Siscoe and Sullivan mines on Lake Montigny, Que.

New Hospital Annex Opened at Kirkland

\$100,000 Addition to Kirkland Lake Hospital Opened Tuesday. Operated by Red Cross.

The new \$100,000 annex to the Kirkland Lake district hospital, the largest of the twenty-six outpost hospitals operated by the Red Cross in Ontario, was officially opened on Tuesday.

The opening of this new annex brings to fruition the efforts of the Kirkland hospital board over the past few years to make adequate provision for the number of patients which has been steadily growing as the town expanded.

Dr. W. S. Caldwell, director of the Red Cross outpost service for Ontario, commenting on the need for this new addition, stated that an outstanding feature of the Kirkland Lake hospital is the large amount of surgery performed.

The financing of the new annex, which has a bed capacity for 70 patients, was accomplished through a donation from the Kirkland Lake mines of approximately \$50,000 and a debenture issue for a similar amount by the township of Teck.

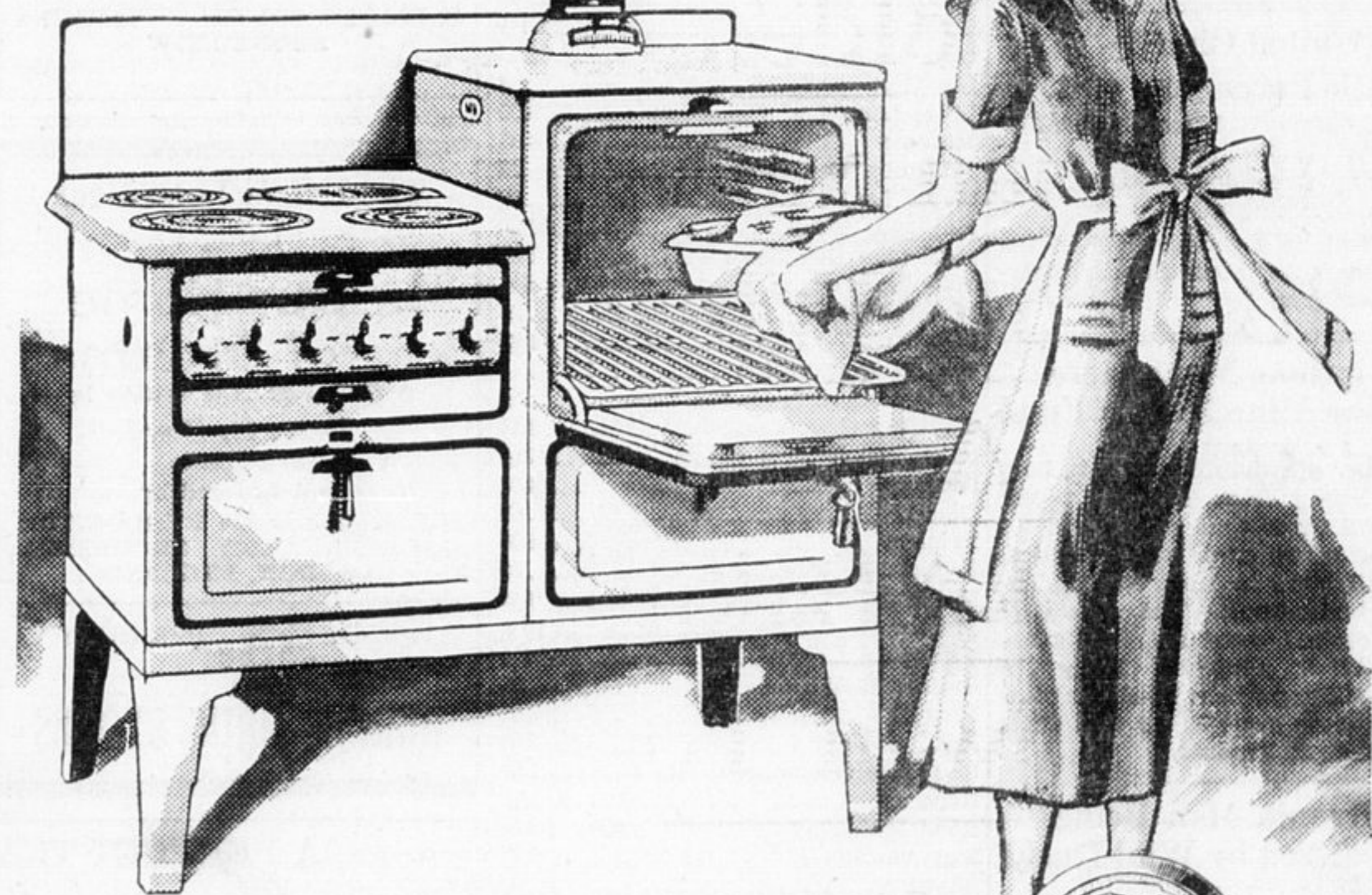
What Women Want in Line of Clothes
