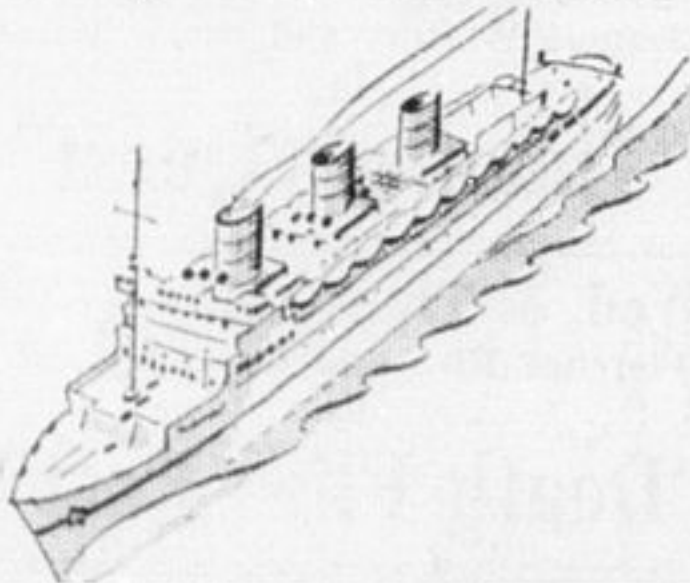

Miss E. Giroux received severe facial injuries ten years ago this week when the car in which she was riding was struck by another car that came out from behind a third, parked on the side of the road.

Empire Day, May 23rd, was to be observed in Central school, The Advance reported.

The famous Rev. Father Paradis died in Montreal just ten years ago. He had been one of the early prospectors of the Porcupine, particularly the Night Hawk Lake area.

He was a native of France and was 78 years of age when he died. During his days he had lived at Temagami, where he had built a church, mainly with his own hands.

COST OF LIVING SHOWS SEASONAL REDUCTION

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics index number of retail prices, rents and costs of services on the base 1926-100, fell from 80.5 in March to 79.8 in April.

An index for retail prices alone including such commodities as foods, coal, coke, clothing, household requirements, etc., declined from 75.9 to 74.8.

Kirkland Lake Motorcycle Rider Swept from Cycle

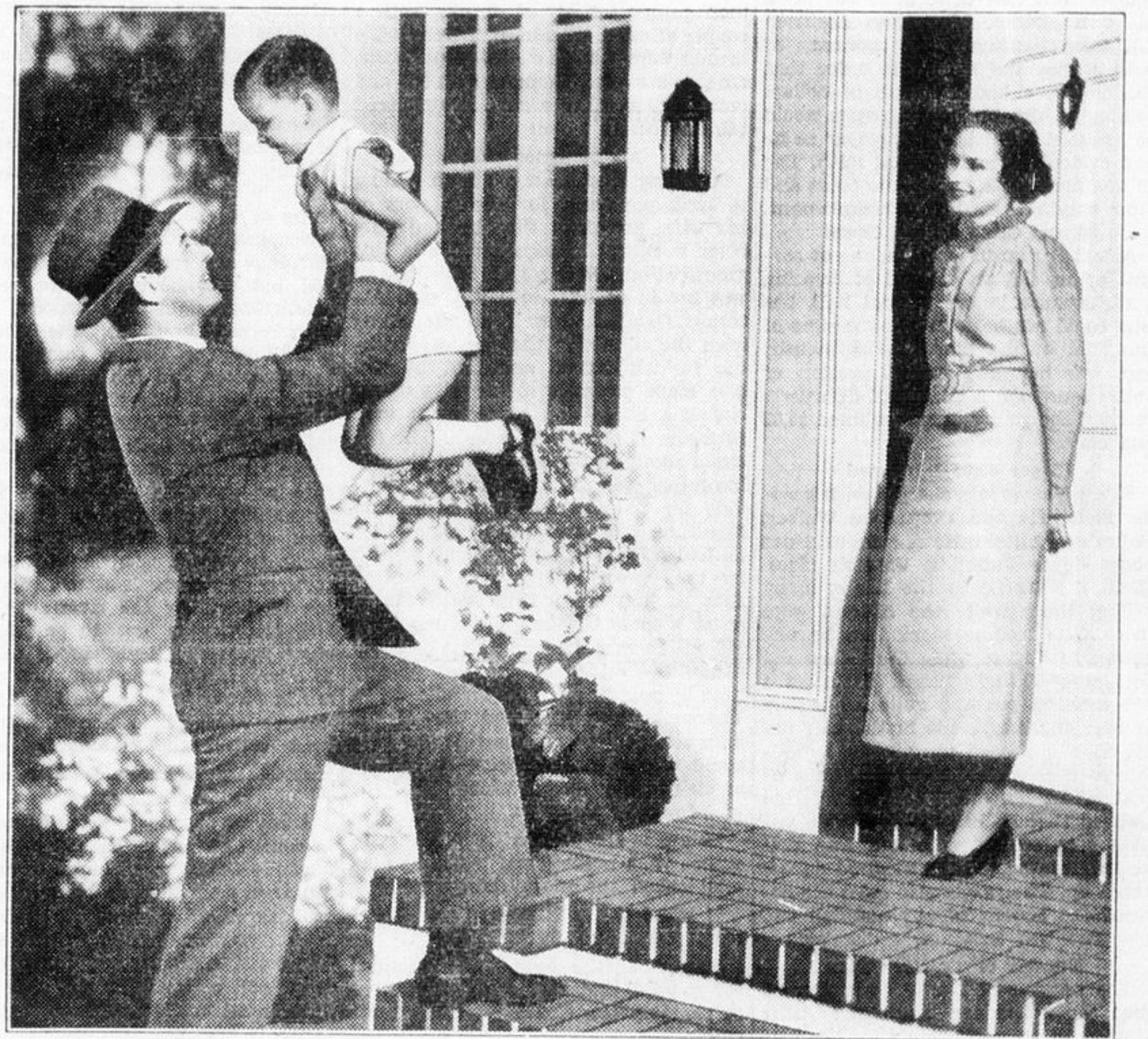
