Fair to moderate weather continuing over the week-end was predicted by the weatherman today.

Last Thursday maximum and minimum temperatures were 36 and 30; Friday, 37 and 26; Saturday, 46 and 25; Sunday, 48 and 30; Monday, 46 and 39; Tuesday, 30 and 29; Wednesday, 30 and 20. Last night's minimum was 22 and at eight o'clock this morning the temperature read 30.

There was rainfall on several different occasions since last Thursday. On Saturday it rained to a depth of .09 inches from seven o'clock in the morning until seven o'clock on the morning of the next day. On the 10th it rained from 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. on the 11th, to a depth of .09 inches. There was a heavy rain from 6 p.m. on Monday until 6 a.m. on Tuesday. .27 inches of rain fell.

On Thursday last, there were light snow flurries all day. Next evidence of snow was on Tuesday when it snowed to the depth of a quarter of an inch from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. On the same day it snowed from 6 p.m. until eight o'clock this morning. Depth, one-half inch.
