These will look ornamental by day and have a glamour when lighted during the evening.

Christmas Greens Fill Baskets Baskets filled with greens and dotted with the novelty units lend notes of appropriate Chrisemas decoration. Any small baskets will do for this purpose. There generally are some about the house, but if not, metal paint or green stain some of the little markets baskets such as scrawberries, brussels sprouts or tomatoes come in. Make a rope or lengths of paper braid for the handles, painted or stained to match the basket. If a length of picture wire has been wound with the strands of papper rope and braid, these handles will keep their shape when ends have been thrust inside the baskets close to their opposite sides. The handles can be wired or glued to the baskets.
