Stand Up and Fight at Palace Theatre

Outstanding Motion Picture for To-night and Tomorrow Night.

This evening and tomorrow (Tuesday) the feature at the Palace theatre is an extra special—"Stand Up and Fight," with Wallace Berry and Robert Taylor co-starring for the first time. Among the supporting cast are Florence Rice, Helen Broderick, and Charles Bickford. The story of "Stand Up and Fight" is about Western Maryland in the early eighteenth-fifties when the railroads and stage coach lines were engaged in a bitter rivalry. There is love interest in this story but it is chiefly notable for its thrilling scenes, which include two flat fights, a saloon brawl, the dynamiting of a jail, a race between train and stage coach, a covered wagon wreck, slave-running and a series of gunfights. The first fights between Robert Taylor and Wallace Berry are most realistic, being of the type where everything goes. While action is the keynote of this film, there is so much of the romance of the past century portrayed and the costumes, appliances, customs and modes of the times are so accurately depicted that all interested in history and the progress of humanity will find "Stand Up and Fight" of most absorbing interest.
