The color of its flesh is uninteresting The flavor is insipid, and yet after it has been pared, carefully cored and cooked with sugar it acquires a lovely red color and a distinctive flavor which makes it the favorite preserve of many persons. In fact, it has given its Spanish name to that division of preserved fruits which we call marmalades.

The cultivation of the quince has not kept pace with that of other fruits. We seldom see perfect specimens on the market, and we must usually resign ourselves to some waste for the sake of the final result. Do not forget when preparing quinces, either for preserve or marmalades or for baking or stewing, every seed and seed pod must be carefully removed. Otherwise you have a gummy instead of a smooth syrup.

You may like to use apples and quinces together for jelly. Apple juice contains more pectin than does quince. Instead of the apple juice, you may, of course, use fruit pectin, which is merely concentrated apple juice.

Quince Jelly 4½ cups quince juice

71/2 cups sugar 26cup bottled pectin


