1844 - - 1939

It all started in 1844 in the little town of Rochdale, England. A small group of workers—27 men and one woman—opened a co-op store. Public response was not very good. The townspeople were skeptical and even a little hostile. Little did they realize that the principles on which this co-op was organized would be the basis of organization of millions of co-operators throughout the world. To-day, most successful co-ops... like the Workers' Co-op... adhere to what have come to be known as the



"ROCHDALE PRINCIPLES"

- HERE THEY ARE:
1. OPEN MEMBERSHIP — Anyone may join.
 2. ONE MAN—ONE VOTE—No matter how many shares a person may have, they just have one vote.
 3. TRADE DIVIDEND—Profits of co-op distributed to customers according to how much they buy at the co-op.
 4. LIMITED INTEREST ON CAPITAL—No more than 6% on shares. Usually 3%.
 5. POLITICAL and RELIGIOUS NEUTRALITY—No affiliation to any political party or religious group.
 6. EDUCATION—Education of membership to be an important part of the co-op program.
 7. CO-OPERATIVE CO-OPERATION—All co-ops to unite their efforts to further the co-operative movement.
