Writing games make an entertaining change for the Christmas party, and are ideal for fitting in between the more boisterous pastimes.

An easy one to start off with is "Telegrams." One player calls out twelve letters of the alphabet, chosen haphazard, and each person then writes out a telegram, using the twelve letters in order as the initial letters of the words

This time each player writes something which has been bequeathed to the person whose name was last written or twelve bequeats have been made to different persons, and the papers are then read out, to the amusement of the

In "Backwards-or-Forwards" the players are asked to make a list of all the words they can think of which make sense either backwards or forwards. For example: star-rats, buddub, moor-room, leper, repel. One mark is scored for each word. Words which read the same backwards or forwards score five, such as tot, bob; or ten if of five letters or more, such as

For "Alliteration" a letter is chosen and players must try to make the best sentence they can with every word beginning with the chosen letter. "Cautious Clara came cleverly carrying charming Chinese cups," is an example.

### Kirkland Council Not Easy on Transient Traders

(From Northern News) In refusing to refund the \$300 transient trader's license, with a discount of business tax, to a firm which went out of business here after two months. Show the Way to Givs Council made a decision this week that was only fair to established merchants here, and sustained a policy which has been followed for 12 years.

The transient trader's fee is taken not exactly as a security for staying in business, but to prevent outside promoters from coming in for a few weeks with "Fire" or "Bankrupt stock" sale, cleaning up, and leaving without contributing a cent to community offers. To the bona fide merchant establishing himself here, the license is not unfair, as in time it pays off his busi-

If a merchant starts a business and is unable to carry on, he has to include his \$300 in his loss. The firm in question, an American one, was hard hit by the exchange rates. But conditions arising out of the war have also hit old-established businesses here, and they have to take their loss.




