

# Noranda Team Wins Major Bowling Trophy

## Eddie Rice's Noranda Team Takes Men's Team Event on Saturday Night With 3808

### McIntyre Jamborees Win Ladies Team Event. Tommy Bonnah Takes Men's Singles and Mary McIntosh-Gordon Wins Ladies' Singles. Tournament Successful.

Eddie Rice's Noranda team walked off with the major prize at the second annual tournament of the Northern Ontario and Quebec Bowling Association held in Timmins on Thursday, Friday and Saturday of last week. Their impressive team total of 3808 was posted early in the afternoon and was never threatened.

The tournament is the most successful that the young organization has yet held and it is expected that Timmins will get next year's tournament. The enthusiasm shown at the tournament was much more than the officials expected and it was hard to stop the bowling on Saturday night. Many more entries were received than the executive expected.

Teams from all parts of Northern Ontario took part in the tournament and one ladies' team came from Toronto. The big names of the tournament entry list disappointed the spectators who found out that they were just ordinary. The Creighton men's team and the Seagram's ladies' team didn't fare as well in the team events as the experts figured they would.

Tommy Bonnah, stalwart of the Advance team for the past two seasons, had little difficulty taking the singles title. His singles mark was scored on Friday night it wasn't till late Saturday night that any of the singles scores started to threaten him.

A cocky band of Frenchmen from the McIntyre entered the tournament on Saturday and took the lead in the team event. Their lead was held for only a short time though, for early in the afternoon Rice's Noranda gang topped them by almost two hundred pins.

The two leading team scores in the ladies' event were bowled on Friday night and their scores weren't threatened till Saturday afternoon when the Beattie Mines Ladies' team sneaked into third place.

Art Sauve and Archie Johnstone posted their winning doubles score on the opening night of the tournament and weren't bothered till Saturday night when the team of Kovach and Gunns of Kirkland Lake came within nine pins of beating them. Cody and Shephard of Timmins were lowered to third place Saturday night.

Minnie Stephens and Blanche Desjardins posted their doubles score on Thursday night and one Saturday night the team of McDowell and Maw of Toronto beat them out by twenty-seven pins to take the ladies' doubles trophy. Mary McIntosh-Gordon stepped out on Saturday to take the ladies' singles and M. McDowell of Toronto got into second place thirty-three pins back.

The Gilmore-Lorrain mark of 1630, set Thursday night was never threatened.

ened. The Timmins team of Art Sauve and Hazel Cottrell were in second place till Saturday night when the team of Vedova and Vedova from Noranda went into second place seven pins ahead of them.

Frank Exell of Kirkland Lake took the Grand Aggregate trophy with a fine count of 2383 for his three events. Leo Campbell of Timmins held the spot till he was ousted on Saturday night. Pat Maw of Toronto took the Ladies' Grand Aggregate with a count of 2641. She beat out M. Gilmore of Timmins by over a hundred pins to take the trophy.

Highest three-game score of the tournament was bowled by Johnny Lorrain in the mixed doubles when he really started to hit the timber and turned in a record-breaking score of 951. Frank Exell had the highest single game of 383. Minnie Stephens had the best three-game mark for the ladies with 814 and she also had the best single with 347.

Teams from Toronto, Sudbury, Kirkland Lake, Noranda, Duparquet, Que., Kapuskasing, Smooth Rock Falls, Iroquois Falls, South Porcupine, Schumacher and Timmins took part in the tournament.
