Police Court Had Close to a Holiday Here This Week

Only a Few Cases and None of Them Important.

This week was close to a holiday week for police court here, there being only a few cases and none of them important.

Mrs. Pete Geroux was charged with illegal possession of liquor, the police finding some of the forbidden stuff in her apartment, though her place some months ago had been declared public and liquor consequently illegal there. He explained that the bottle in question had been left there by her son while home on leave for the holiday from the Army. The magistrate imposed the minimum fine of \$100 and costs in view of the circumstances. Two other couples were charged with being "found-in." Only one of them was asked to give evidence. She told about meeting Mrs. Geroux on street on New Year's Day, while she and her husband and her father and mother were out for a walk. They had been neighbours of Mrs. Geroux last year and when she invited them to her apartment they had no idea that they would run counter to the law. The invitation was simply a friendly one. The magistrate dismissed the four charges, commenting that it did not appear to be a case of being "found-in," but simply a friendly visit.

Canadian Soldiers' Paper Published Somewhere in Italy

Little Newspaper Shows that the Canadian Soldier Hasn't Lost his Morale or Humour.

A friend of The Advance has loaned The Advance a copy of "The Red Patch," the little newspaper edited, printed and published by the First Canadian Division—Central Mediterranean Force. While the newspaper is printed in English, some oddities about it suggest that it was turned out in an Italian printing office. The paper itself gives its circulation as 4,000.

In addition to news, regimental orders, etc., the chief items in the soldiers' newspaper are wit and humour. One example of wit is the line—

"Men are only earthen jugs with spirits in them."

Illustrations of humour include:—
