### More Needed, However, to Reach the Quota Set For Coming Year to Fight Tuberculosis in the Porcupine. Plan Sponsored by the Lions Club Has Achieved Much in the Past. Still More Need to Continue and Extend the Campaign.

We would wish our people at home to have our most heartfelt greetings and good wishes for the coming season and to have them know that we shall be with them in spirit and hope that the future season shall see us all reunited."

Special Christmas parcels from the Canadian Red Cross were distributed to the prisoners.

## Notice of Passing of By-Law No. 863

### BY-LAW NO. 863

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law Number 816.

WHEREAS an application has been presented to the Council to pass a by-law amending By-law No. 816.

AND WHEREAS it has been deemed desirable to amend the said by-law accordingly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Town of Timmins as follows:

- Paragraph 1 of By-law 816 is amended by striking out the word "nine" in the sixth line thereof, and substituting therefore the word "seven".
- Paragraph 1. of this By-law shall become effective on and after January 1st, 1945.
- Notice of the passing of this By-law shall be published in the Daily Press and Porcupine Advance newspapers on a day between December 26th and December 30th, 1944.

READ and finally passed this eighteenth day of December, A.D. 1944.

Paragraph 1 of By-law No. 816, as amended by the above by-law, now reads as follows:

"I. On all Saturdays throughout the year, on the three week days immediately preceding Christmas Day and on all days which precede a Legal Holiday as defined by the Interpretation Act or as so proclaimed by the Mayor or Council of the Town of Timmins, all Barber Shops in the Town of Timmins shall be closed at the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon and shall remain continuously closed thereafter until five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day."
