

# 'Tarzan' Lopez Hands Out ★ Sports - So What! ★ McIntyre Loses In Second Defeat To Garner Friday Night's Game

Fans Have To Help Garner Back In Ring In Kinsmen's Second Show

Juan Tarzan Lopez triumphed over Red Garner once again in their return bout at the Kinsmen's Second Show.

The bout between the short-necked Mexican exponent and Torontonian Garner was fought as a return bout with Garner out to avenge his defeat at the Tarzan's hands in their last bout here. But after a series of elbow smashes in the second session of their no curfew bout, the mighty Red collapsed and was carried from the ring to remain unconscious for the first five minutes in his dressing room and then to proceed to attempt to battle imaginary opponents as he came out of his knock-out.

To begin the bout, the Tarzan "Ah-Chaa-ed" and began bouncing Garner around the groan box until at last with one mighty fling he heaved Garner over the ropes and into the first row. When Garner attempted to return, Lopez gave him the boots and knocked him to the floor again. Then with fiendish brilliance Lopez allowed Red to get back into the ring and then chucked him out again with more height on the throw and a slow spin on Garner's body to make his landing anything but three-point. To relieve the monotony of tossing Garner out, the Garner heaved Tarzan out and let go at that.

The little Mexican returned to the ring and used a series of body slams and a top spread to pin Garner at the eighteen-minute mark, with Garner having to be assisted to his dressing room.

Starting the second session, Tarzan displayed his strength by breaking two

"full Nelson's" that Garner applied and then peed, Garner threw Tarzan out of the ring. Equally peeved when he returned to the ring, Lopez bit Garner's leg in retaliation for a bite in the early part of the bout and then both boys made attempts at elbow smashes and knees in the face, with Tarzan getting the upper hand and pummeling Garner for a full five minutes until Garner fell out of the ring.

With the assistance of a fan, Garner was returned to the groan box where the pummeling continued until referee Johnny Anderson was forced to halt the fight.

Garner had been out for quite some time, but Lopez would not let him lay until the fight had to be stopped at the 47-minute mark.

In the semi-final the bad boy, Tiger Grant, lost on disqualification to Jimmy Allan when he began taking friend James head in his arm and running across the ring and ramming Allan's head on the posts until he cut the head and drew blood. With Grant moaning about the decision, Allan shoved him's head and Grant looked it over and then belted the bumpy bean and started the fight again for a few moments until they were wrenched apart.

To begin the scrap, Allan dumped Grant on his face which did little for Tiger's temper. He jumped up and down and then started running around the ring in circles, only to fall on a rope bouncing stunt. Then Allan got Tiger's head in the ropes and commenced to twist until stopped by Referee Buddy Mangotich, who sored up the James and was attacked by same, Grant got Allan's head in and then changed about until Allan, a little fatigued by the neck and rope massage, was thrown by Tiger with a body slam and top spread at the 23-minute mark.

Tiger went into a tantrum then, implying that he was invincible and asked anybody to fight but complying with the high standard of intellect in this section of the country, no one would.

But alas and alack, when the Tiger made his way to his dressing room a lady took a swine at him, missing when Grant ducked.

Returning with fingers spread in "V" for Victory, Grant lasted a few moments and then Allan threw him all over the ring, but his head in the ropes and jumped on the ropes to add to the agony and embarrassment and then threw Grant with a back throw and double arm lock at the 29-minute mark to make Grant madder than you know what.

The final session of head beating on the posts was halted with the referee disqualifying Grant.

In the preliminary, Steve Szalek and Pete Perno went at it for 15 minutes, terminating the bout that began with much hugging with Szalek throwing Perno with the Indian death lock.

Refereeing the preliminary and semifinal was Buddy Mangotich with Johnny Anderson taking the final between Garner and Lopez.
