WORRIER SHADOW BOXES IMAGINARY FOE

Do you know what habit dissipates your energy and gives you more headaches than any other? Well, although I may never have met you personally, I can tell you. That is, I can unless you are one of the fortunate persons who has conquered that habit, which is worry. Yet worrying is usually a stupid, senseless activity. Most worriers use the same technique in handling trouble that a prizefighter uses when training for a fight.

When Jim Corbett trained for his historic fight with the mighty John L. Sullivan — the fight that made Corbett a world champion — Corbett devoted an hour or more every day to shadow boxing, to striking at an imaginary opponent who wasn't there.

When Jim Corbett shadow boxed, he perfected his timing and footwork, strengthened his legs and built up his mind.

But when you shadow box with worries, you are just tearing yourself to pieces. Yet, within a few blocks of where you are sitting now, there are people who are doing just that — ducking and side-stepping and trying to ward off imaginary blows that haven't yet been struck — people who are working themselves into a veritable lather, not about what is happening now, but what they fear may happen. Shadow boxing!

They get so wrought up that their muscles are taut, their jaws set. Their

instincts churn, their hearts pound. Are these shadow boxers doing any constructive thinking or planning? No, they are merely going around in circles, saying the same things over and over — striking imaginary blows. "If he does this, I am going to do that... if I lose my job, how will I eat... if she nags me just once more, I'm going to pack up and leave". Shadow boxing. Futile, tragic shadow boxing!

Cardinal Newman wrote down a thought which came to him during an hour of great distress. I pass it on to you and I hope you will carry it in mind and apply its philosophy the next time worry besets you. It is: "One step at a time is enough for me."
