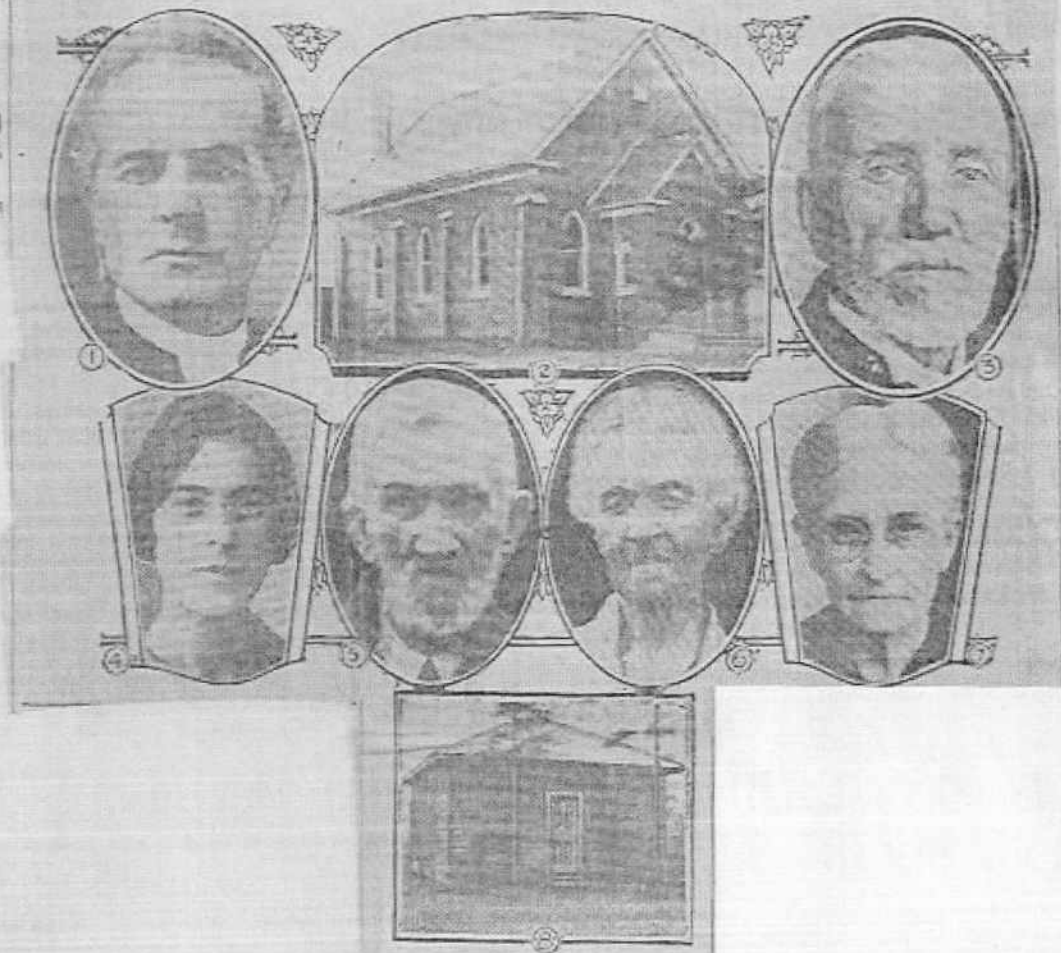


### Diamond Anniversary at Sheridan United Church
