## June 1915

Pt. Leslie Bradley, of the 4<sup>th</sup> Battalian wrote to his mother June 3 at Hornby.

A Burlington man and I had just finished burying an unknown soldier behind our trenches the other day and made a rough little cross for a mark, when whiz bang we were over in our dugout in the fraction of a moment, but it was close. It just smashed the cross up into kindling wood and dug a huge hole alongside ready for the next man.
