incomplete dates.

Finding payrolls for particular historical events can help clarify who took part in those events. The following were the engagements in which the 5th Lincoln took part and the related payroll documents:

Aug. 16, 1812, Capture of Detroit, Capt. Samuel Hatt's Co. Not found in this collection.

Oct. 13, 1812, the Battle of Queenston Heights, Capt. Hatt's and Durand's Flank Companies Volume 24, Documents 323 to 324 and Volume 25, Documents 43 to 46

Nov. 28, 1812, Frenchman's Creek, Capt. Hatt's Co. Volume 24, Document 337

May 11 or 12, 1813, the Attack on the King's Head Inn, Capt. Hatt's Co. Volume 24, Document 345

July 25, 1814, the Battle of Lundy's Lane, Lt. Col. Andrew Bradt's Detachment No muster or payroll record has been found.

The transcriber has used these and other documents to compile an alphabetical muster roll. He is in the process of writing a biography for each of the men who served in this regiment and welcomes enquiries.
