HELP PREVENT FOREST FIRES

The forest fire season is upon us and we all must do everything possible to prevent forest fires. For everyone's information, general instructions recently posted throughout the project, are reprinted here:

CAMP FIRES: Every camp fire must be totally extinguished before the person making it, leaves the place.

SMOKING: Smoking material, lighted matches or any burning substance must be thoroughly extinguished before being thrown away.

FIRE FIGHTING: Able-bodied male citizens must assist in fire fighting when called upon to do so by a Fire Ranger.

DEPARTMENT OF LANDS AND FORESTS' PROPERTY: Fire signs and all Department of Lands and Forests'

property must not be interfered with.

TRAVELLERS: Persons travelling through the woods must give information as to their names, addresses and movements when requested by a Fire Ranger. Smoking while walking through the bush is prohibited. No lunch fires or fires for any other purpose will be permitted in the bush. Any fire must be reported to the Fire Chief immediately.

PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF FIRE LAW: Penalty for violation of Fire Law -- up to \$300.00 and imprisonment up to ninety days.
