SOFTBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION

League standings and schedules will be published weekly in Terrace Bay News. Points which determine team standings will be allotted as follows: Win - 2 points; Tie - 1 point; Loss - 0 points. Games may be postponed only in the following cases without default: (1) In case of inclement weather. (2) By notice in writing to the opposition-team Manager and/or Association President, Dick Rigby, in which event, notice must be given by 3:00 p.m. on the day prior to the scheduled game. (3) By order of the President. If a game is postponed, it is up to the respective Team Managers to play that game on an off-night, otherwise it will have to be played at the end of the regular schedule.

The league ends officially on August 31st. Postponed games will be played from Sept 1 - 7th. Playoffs will run from Sept 7th - 15th.

The first three teams in each league will play each other in sudden death semi-finals. The
