Staggering facts issued by the Canadian Forestry Association give some indication of the colossal loss of forest resources caused by forest fires in Canada.

6000 annual forest fires destroy an average of 400 million cubic feet of our country's heritage as 2,500,000 acres of woodland are obliterated. This represents a yearly path of devastation a mile wide all the way from Halifax to Vancouver

and northward to the edge of Alaska.
