During switchboard hours (7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.) call Fire Hall at Local 22. At all other hours, Townsite phone is connected directly with Fire Hall. Give location of fire slowly and distinctly including house number and street if possible. Following the phone call, snap on siren switch in phone booth and remain at the booth to direct fire crews to the fire. <u>LOWER CAMP</u> Go directly to the Fire Hall and report location of the fire. <u>UPPER CAMP</u> AND MILLSITE Go to nearest phone (on wall in front of building #103 or at the rear of the Time Office). During switchboard hours (7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.) call Fire Hall at Local 22. At all other hours the phones referred to above are connected directly with Fire Hall. Give location of the fire slowly and distinctly including the number of the building closest to fire if possible. If using phone at rear of Time Office, snap on siren following phone call. -0--
