## Merchandise Rates to U.S.A.

l¢ per oz., (minimum 3¢) for parcels weighing up to 8 ounces.

Parcel post over 8 ozs. to 10 lbs. - 14¢ per lb.

10 lbs. to 15 lbs. - \$1.75 per parcel.

Customs requirements on parcel post up to 8 ozs. at the 1¢ rate: all packets paid at letter rate and all packets paid at "printed matter" rate require a Customs Declaration or invoice with a green label #185 affixed to packets.

To non-commercial parcels 8 ozs. to 15 lbs. - affix a Customs Declaration. In addition to Customs Declaration, commercial shipments also require an invoice enclosed.

To allow for Customs inspection all parcels for the U.S.A. should be mailed prior to December 10th.

Mailing dates in Canada are as follows:

British Columbia - Dec. 15th
Alberta & Sask. - Dec. 16th

Local Delivery by December 19th. (If posted later Christmas delivery cannot be assured.)

Manitoba & the Maritimes - Dec. 17th
Ontario and Quebec - Dec. 18th
