

UNSAFE PILING

Recently there has been one serious accident and several minor ones, due to unsafe piling of materials. These accidents could have been avoided by observing a few simple rules.

1. Material should be piled evenly and against a permanent wall if possible.
2. Do not pile material too high.
3. When removing material from a pile, remove from the top and work down evenly.
4. Block all round or oval objects on both ends.
