

1. Always choose proper type of truck for materials. Put small pieces in tote box. Keep properly balanced.

2. Keep sharp lookout while pushing truck, give warning to

workers in path. Keep head up, hands on rail.

See that doorways, and other narrow passageways allow ample clearance for hands.

See that truck is in good condition before using it. Keep

wheels oiled, check rims, lifting mechanism, etc. 5. Leave handles of parked trucks in upright positions; never leave them on floor to cause tripping hazard.
