BOY SCOUT ORGANIZATION FORMED A general meeting was held in the Community Hall Tuesday evening, May 3rd, for the purpose of electing a Group Committee to act for the Scout group at Terrace Bay.

Approximately forty interested persons attended the meeting held under the Chairman-

Introduced by Herman Roberts, the Chairman spoke on Scouting and the necessity of forming this Group Committee in compliance with the Dominion Scout Association rules of organization. Mr. Craig's remarks of his own experience as an Eagle Scout and of the introduction of Boy Scouts to Canada 41 years ago proved very interesting.

Of particular interest was a talk by Bruce Grant, District Scout Commissioner, who came from Fort William to address the meeting. Mr. Grant outlined the policy, principles, and aims of the Scout Association in Canada, covering all phases of organization of new Cub Packs and Scouts. He also spoke of the necessity of the Group Committee, its functions and responsibility as regards able Scout Leadership.

Mr. Lundgren, Scoutmaster of the Schreiber Troop, extended his support and co-opera-

tion in any future joint activity undertaken by the two Scout Troops.

The following were elected to the Group Committee: Herman Roberts, Ralph Buck, Ed Cavanaugh, Dr. J. Shaunessy, and Wilf Ogden, Secretary.

It is the intention to have the two local Church Boards appoint one representative

each to the above Committee. These will be announced later.
