BUILDING BY-LAW NOW IN FORCE AT TERRACE BAY A By-law to provide for the issuing of building permits and the filing of plans and specifications of all buildings and structures in the Improvement District of Terrace Bay was recently enacted by the Board of Trustees and has received approval of the Department of Municipal Affairs.

Under the terms of the By-law "no person, firm or corporation shall commence or proceed with any excavation for, or erection, alteration, addition to, reconstruction, removal or wrecking of any building or structure or any part thereof" without first obtaining a permit from the Improvement District. Fees for permits have been set according to the value of the building or structure involved.
