"SAFETY HAS NO QUITTING TIME"

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A WORD ABOUT LIME BURNS Once again the question of the treatment of lime burns has arisen and we are in receipt of a letter from Dr. R. B. Sutherland, Division of Industrial Hygiene, Province of Ontario, in which he suggests the use of talcum powder as a skin protection. The powder is shaken on the exposed areas thus exerting a cooling action on the skin, and decreasing the tendency to sweating. When sweating does occur the sweat is soaked up by the powder thus reducing the amount of moisture which will react with the lime, and the paste formed on the skin by the mixture of sweat and powder will form a protective film which prevents the lime from coming into contact with the skin. The powder should be applied several times during a shift.

Personal cleanliness of the worker is also of great importance, according to Dr. Sutherland. The employee should change his clothes on leaving the job so as to avoid wearing lime dusted clothing away from work. The lime should be completely removed from the skin before going to meals and at the end of work.

All lime burns or irritations of the skin from lime should be reported to the First Aid Room for treatment.
