A disabling lost-time accident on December 22nd brought to an end our safe run of 130 consecutive days when we were just 30,000 man hours short of our "HALF-MILLION SAFE MAN HOUR OBJECTIVE". We were also only 70 days away from a 200 day objective and another Community Safety Party similar to the one held on December 8th to celebrate 100 safe days.

A decision has now been reached, however, whereby LongLac Pulp and Paper Co. will stage another party or community event just as soon as the present 130 safe day record is passed. What we have done before we can do again, so let's prevent accidents and set new records during this new year of 1950.
