ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS

The following is important information regarding the answering of Fire Alarms in Terrace Bay.

When reporting a fire, <u>Dial 22</u> and be sure to give the exact location of the fire. Phone booths for TURNING IN FIRE ALARMS are located in the Townsite at corner of HUDSON AND SELKIRK--AT THE MILLSITE IT IS LOCATED ON THE WEST WALL OF THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

A series of short blasts on the Mill whistle will be followed by one long blast for the Townsite, SHORT BLAST followed by two long blasts will indicate the South Camp or SHORT BLAST followed by three long blasts for a fire in the Mill. These signals will be repeated 3 times. In the case of a Mill fire, the Townsite siren will not be sounded unless a second alarm is required.

Unless you are a member of the Townsite Fire Brigade <u>DO NOT</u> use the telephone. This is very important, as overuse of the telephones might hamper the Fire Brigade in calling for extra equipment, help, medical aid, etc.

If you attend a fire, please stand well back, ready to help, until requested to do so by the Fire Chief.
