As we go to press our safety record now stands at 34 safe days, more than 119,000 safe man hours and we have now passed the 25% mark on our way to exceeding our previous 130 safe day record, in which event LongLac Pulp and Paper Co. will stage another Safety Party or Community event.

Just for the records, here's an interesting picture of our accident Frequency Rate (disabling lost-time accidents per million man-hours worked.)

Frequency Rate for 1949	13.76
Frequency Rate for the past 5½ months	1.69
