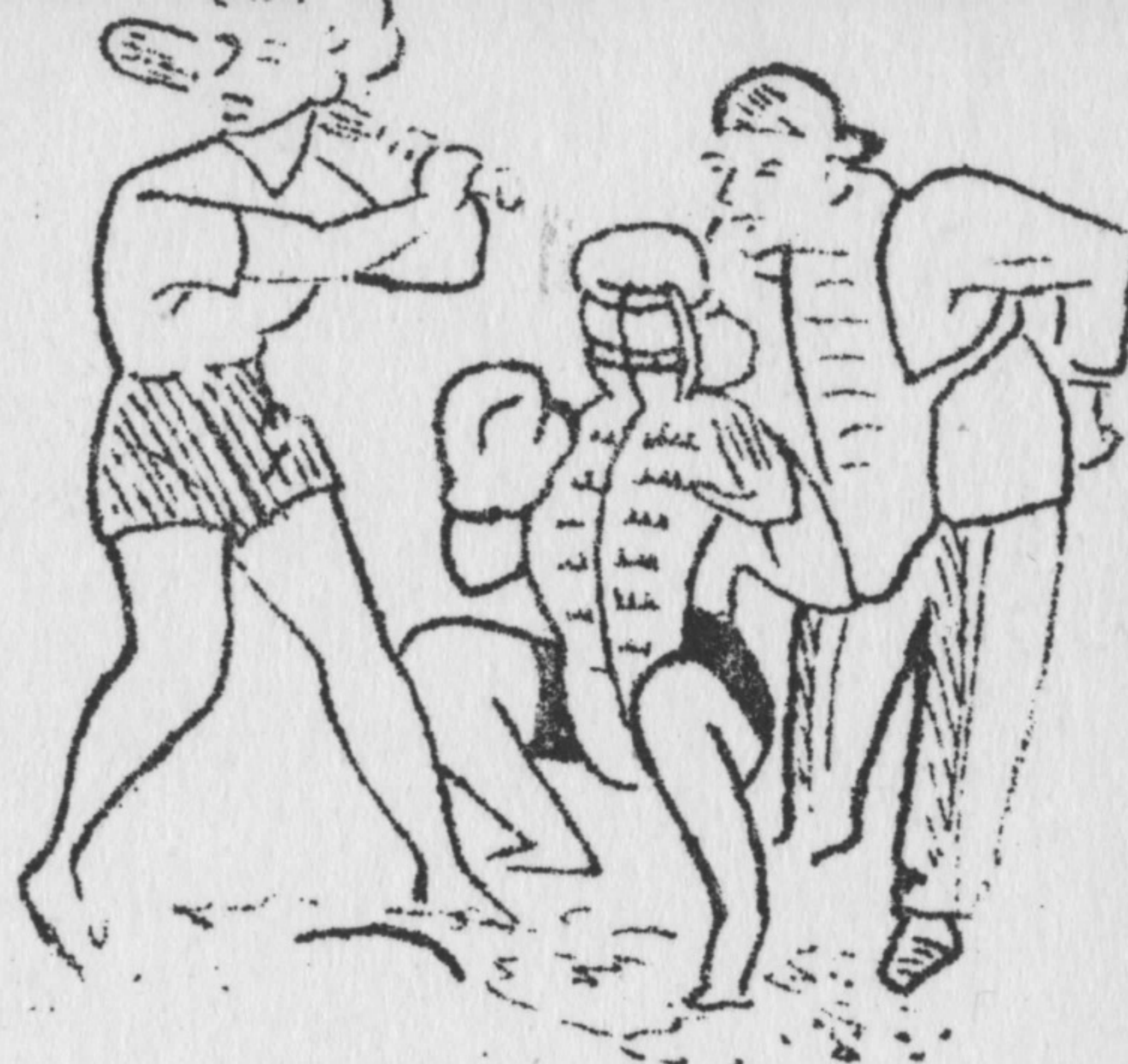
Tuesday, August 8th.
