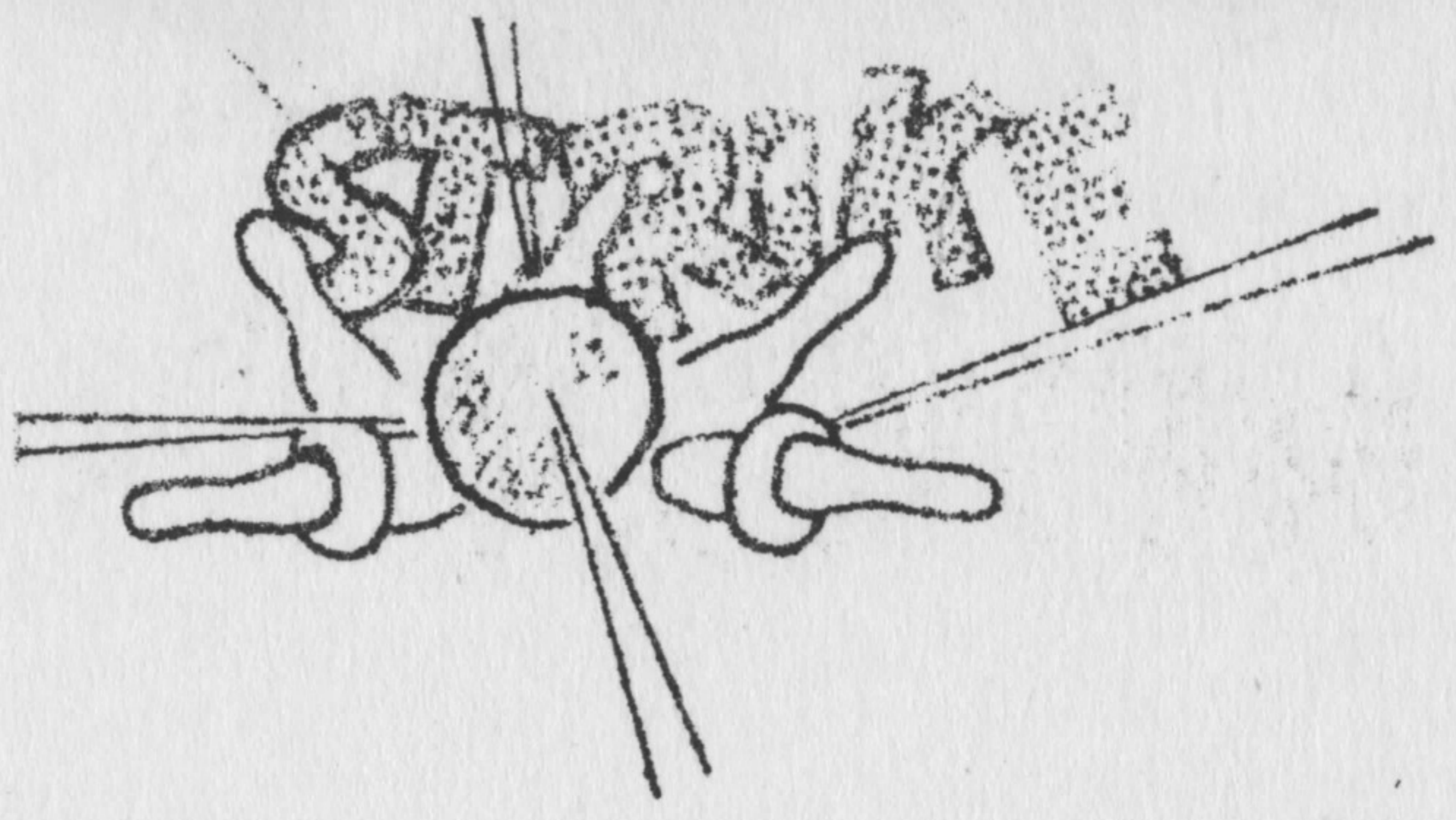


Community Church
