EASTER SEAL OBJECTIVE

Objective for the Easter Seal Campaign of the Ontario Society for Crippled Children was exceeded this year, it was announced at an executive meeting of the society recently. Returns to date are \$380,341.49 as compared with the objective of \$375,000.00. Reports from some of the service clubs which participated in the campaign are not complete and the figure announced recently will be increased by the final tabulation.

Among other projects, the Society operates summer camps for handicapped children at Woodeden, London; Blue Mountain, Collingwood; and Merrywood in the Rideau Lakes District. It also operates Variety Village, Toronto vocation school for crippled children, which is financed by the Toronto Variety Club. The Society's newest undertaking is a cerebral palsy centre at London. This has been in operation more than a year and the work there is being continually expanded. This summer cerebral palsy demonstration clinics will tour the province. All of those persons in Terrace Bay and vicinity who contributed to this worthy cause will be pleased to learn of the foregoing. The campaign for this District was handled by the Kiwanis Club of Terrace Bay and they take this opportunity of offering a sincere hearty thanks to all who made
